

**JIMMY'S FOOD STORE:** Jimmy's makes a gargantuan Italian sub sandwich, thick with the genuine Italian deli meats Jimmy's is known for stocking. The fellow behind the counter builds each sandwich slowly. He begins with a 12-inch length of crusty bread. He adds layers of salami, ham and mortadella with provolone cheese, then sprinkles vinaigrette. He slices the whole thing into two 6-inch halves and rolls them up into a large sheet of white paper.
